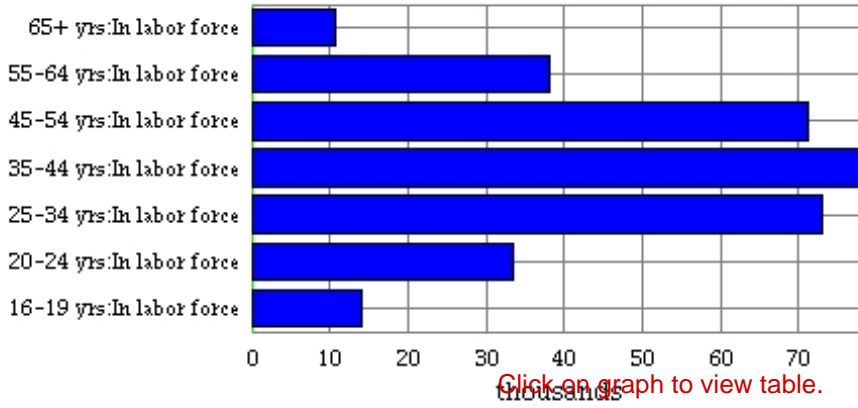

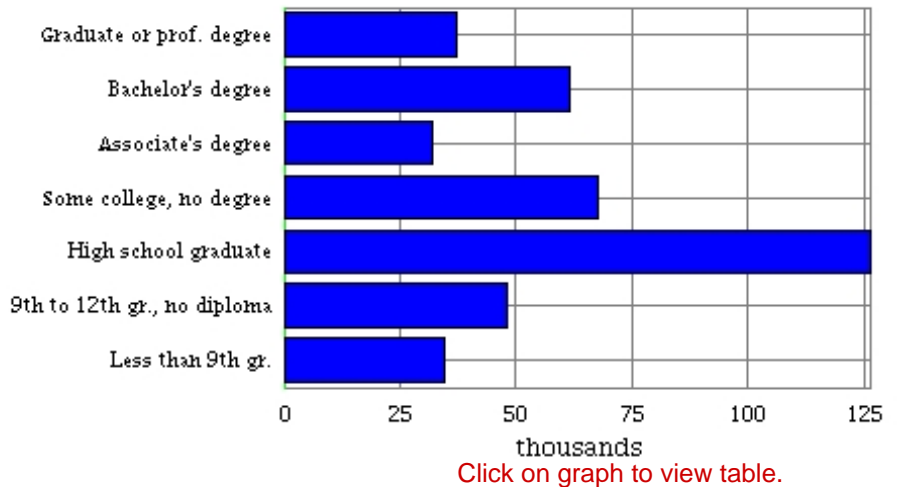
Education

Education Levels for the Population Age 25 and Older









